The Taishan Mountains were elected to the "World Heritage List" in 1987 and are recognized as a symbol of power in the Chinese culture.

Taishan Marigold is a new introduction that will be available in 2010 to the trade. In Chinese, Taishan means stability, which seems to be very fitting as Taishan Marigolds consistently withstand damage from shipping better than competing African Marigolds. In addition, Taishan offers stronger branching for improved landscape performance and delivers excellent, high-impact color.
