Common Problems

Relatively problem-free, except is more vigorous and needs more PGR than L. angustifolia.

Finishing Key Tips

Grow relatively dry and provide active climate. Vigorous Lavandula needs more PGRs than L. angustifolia and L. stoechas, and is a long-flowering annual.
